Weight and Volume - Measure and begin to record the following: mass/weight [for example, heavy/light, heavier than, lighter than] capacity and volume [for example, full/empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter]

Multiplication and Division - Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals: count in multiples of twos, fives and tens

Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher
